Software Licensing Information

All Sun's software products are subject to the terms and conditions of Sun's End User Object Code License, unless otherwise indicated for a particular product. Customers not willing to comply with those terms and customers who do not have agreements with Sun modifying those terms are not authorized to use Sun's software products.

The End User Object Code License provides that the licensed software may be used by the number of users for which the corresponding licensing fee has been paid. Licensing coverage for each product is defined with the ordering information and product descriptions found with each product. A license cannot be shared between two separate companies. Licenses cannot be transferred without authorization from Sun. Following is an overview of the types of licensing governing Sun's software products.

Types of Licensing

Number of "Uses" Licensed

Products licensed in this manner allow the sharing of software up to a maximum limit determined by the number of "uses" licensed. Examples of types of uses licensed are user, sessions, clients, and gateways. The "uses" may be bound by limitations such as a network, building, or site. Any limitations will be described in the ordering notes found with each product.

Licensed for a Specific System, Board, Printer, or SBus Card

In this situation, the software can be used on only one "designated" system, board, printer, or SBus card. Once equipment is designated, the customer needs authorization from Sun to transfer a license to other equipment.

Geographic Limitations

This type of licensing allows extensive usage of the software within a specified geographic area. The most common geographic limitation is a Site License.

A Site License authorizes the use of the licensed software and its associated documentation on a maximum of 500 systems at a customer site. A site is defined as a building or building complex within a one-half (1/2) mile radius of the "Ship To Address" specified on the Purchase Acknowledgment of the order for the licensed software. In certain cases, Sun may grant exceptions to the standard definition of a site, provided that all requests are submitted to Sun in writing. Sun shall make the final determination of what defines a "site."

Default Marketing Parts

When no release is specified, the product shipped will be licensed with the latest release level available at the time of shipment.
